During Ramadan, we distributed essential food packs to under-privileged families, ensuring they had adequate nourishment throughout the holy month

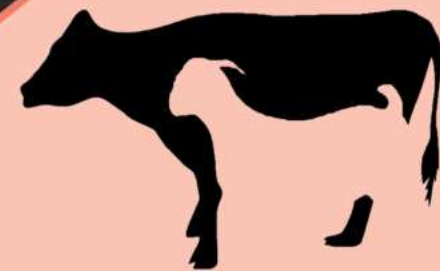

A total of 3,600 hand pumps were installed, providing safe water to 25,200 indirect beneficiaries.

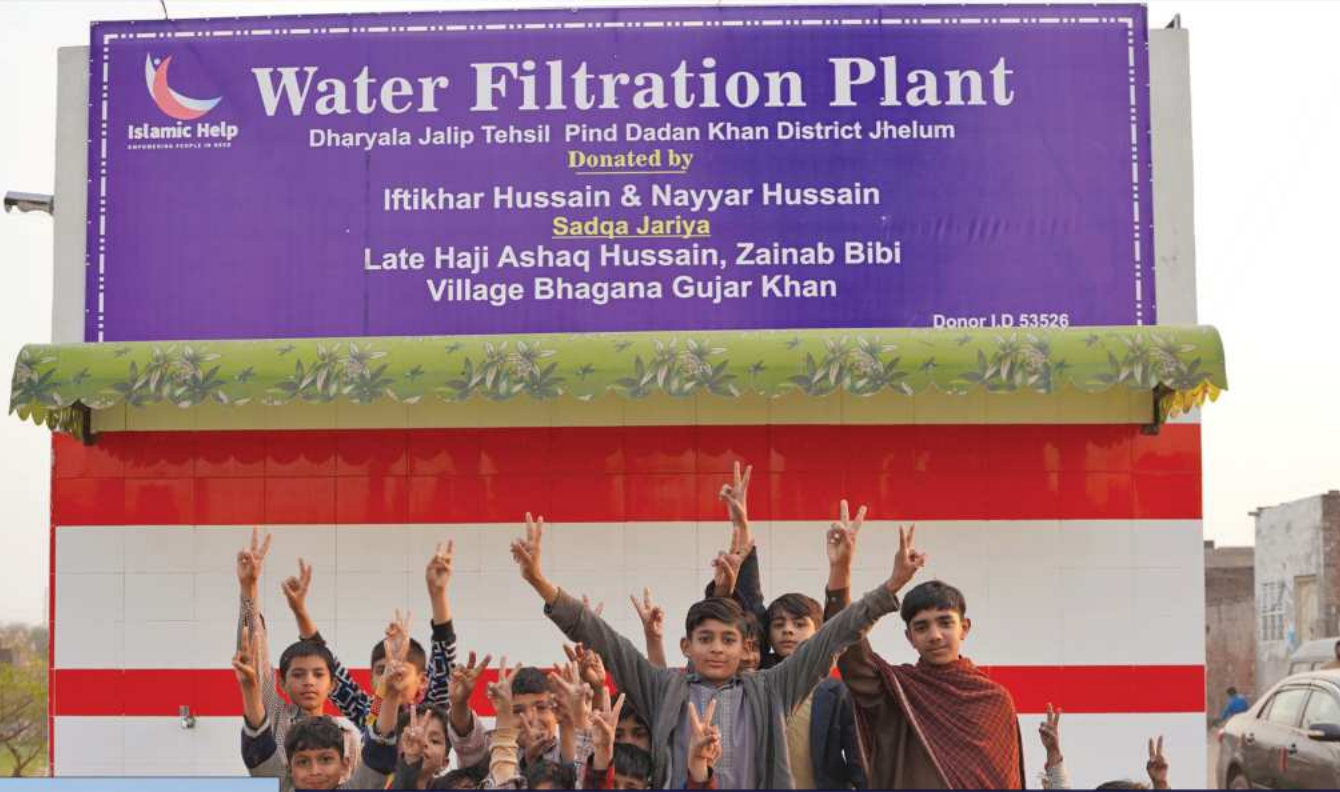


WATER & SANITATION

Water Filtration Plants

21,000 direct beneficiaries

With the installation of 12 filtration plants, 21,000 direct beneficiaries now have access to clean drinking water, significantly reducing waterborne diseases. These state-of-the-art filtration systems ensure the removal of harmful contaminants, providing safe and sustainable water solutions for underserved communities.

EDUCATION



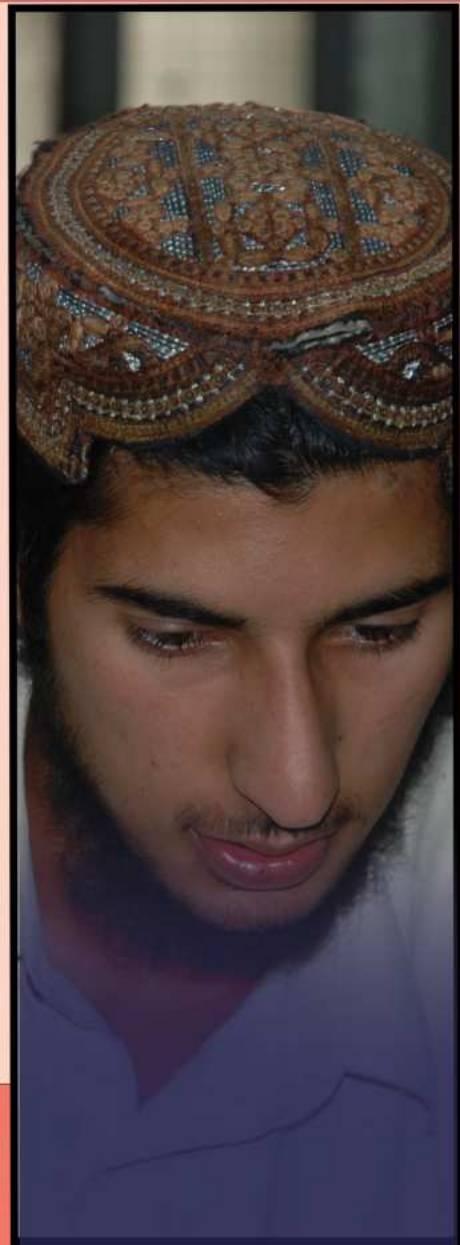
Our educational initiatives continue to support students in low-income communities.

This year, we enrolled over 500 students in various skill development programs to enhance employability and future prospects





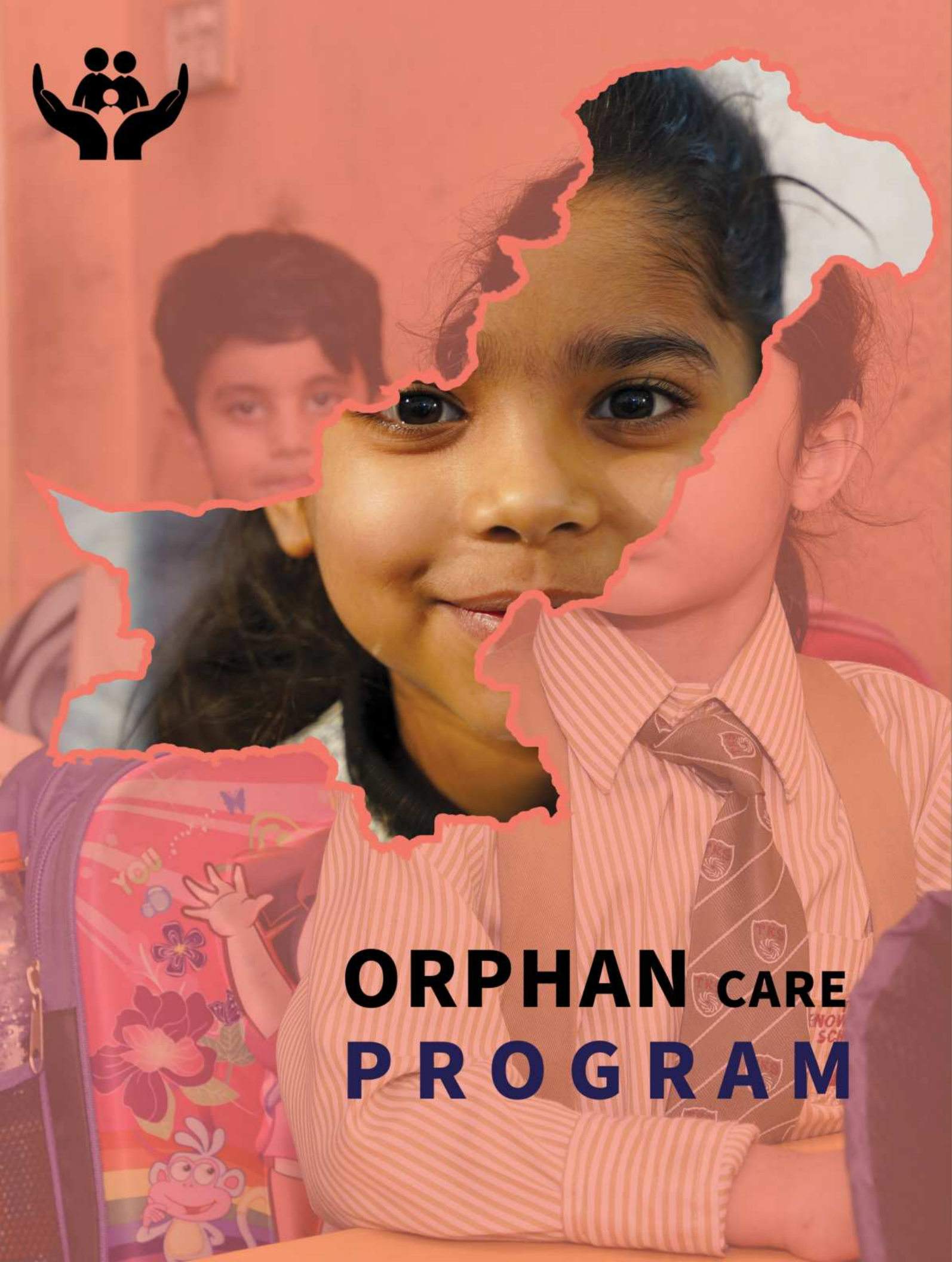
HEALTH CARE



Our medical assistance projects provided essential healthcare services, including eye camps, medical screenings, and hygiene awareness sessions, benefiting thousands across underserved communities. In addition to these initiatives, we facilitated free medical consultations, distributed life-saving medicines, and organized maternal and child healthcare programs to address critical health concerns.

Mobile health units were deployed to remote areas, ensuring that even the most vulnerable populations had access to quality healthcare. Vaccination drives were conducted to prevent the spread of infectious diseases, while nutrition programs focused on combating malnutrition among children and pregnant women. Through these comprehensive healthcare interventions, we have significantly improved community well-being and promoted a healthier future for all.





ORPHAN CARE PROGRAM



Operating since 2005, our Orphan Care Program supports 400 orphan children, providing them with shelter, education, and healthcare. Through financial grants and awareness programs, we continue to protect their rights and improve their quality of life.





EID GIFTS

To bring happiness to orphaned children during festive occasions, we distributed Eid gifts, including new clothes, shoes, toys, and sweets. Special Eid celebrations were organized, allowing children to experience the joy of the occasion just like their peers. These efforts not only uplift their spirits but also reinforce a sense of belonging and love, ensuring that they do not feel left out during these special moments. Through the generosity of our donors, we continue to spread smiles and create lasting memories for these children.





COMMUNITY SERVICES



MOSQUES & MADRASAS PROGRAM



In 2024, we constructed 60 mosques, ensuring proper places of worship for 6,000 direct beneficiaries.

These mosques not only provide a safe and comfortable space for prayer but also serve as community hubs for social, educational, and spiritual growth. Each mosque is equipped with essential amenities, including water facilities, classrooms for religious education, and spaces for community gatherings and events.



WINTERIZATION KITS

This year, 450 winter kits were distributed, benefiting 3,150 indirect beneficiaries, providing warm clothing, blankets, and essential supplies to those facing harsh winter conditions.



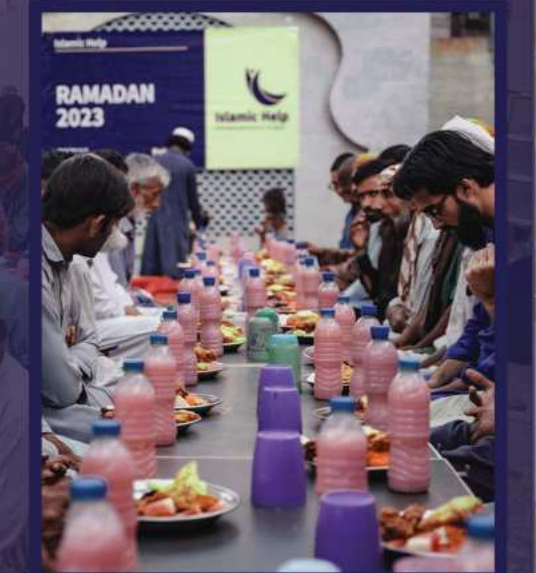
RAMADAN FOOD PACKS

Vocational Training

In parallel to these income-generating initiatives, we have continued to invest in vocational training programs aimed at equipping individuals with the skills needed for long-term career development. By enhancing employability and building practical skills, we ensure that beneficiaries can access diverse job opportunities, further contributing to their financial independence.

Through direct cash assistance and micro-enterprise funding, we empowered vulnerable families to become self-sufficient and economically independent.

Provision of Rickshaws

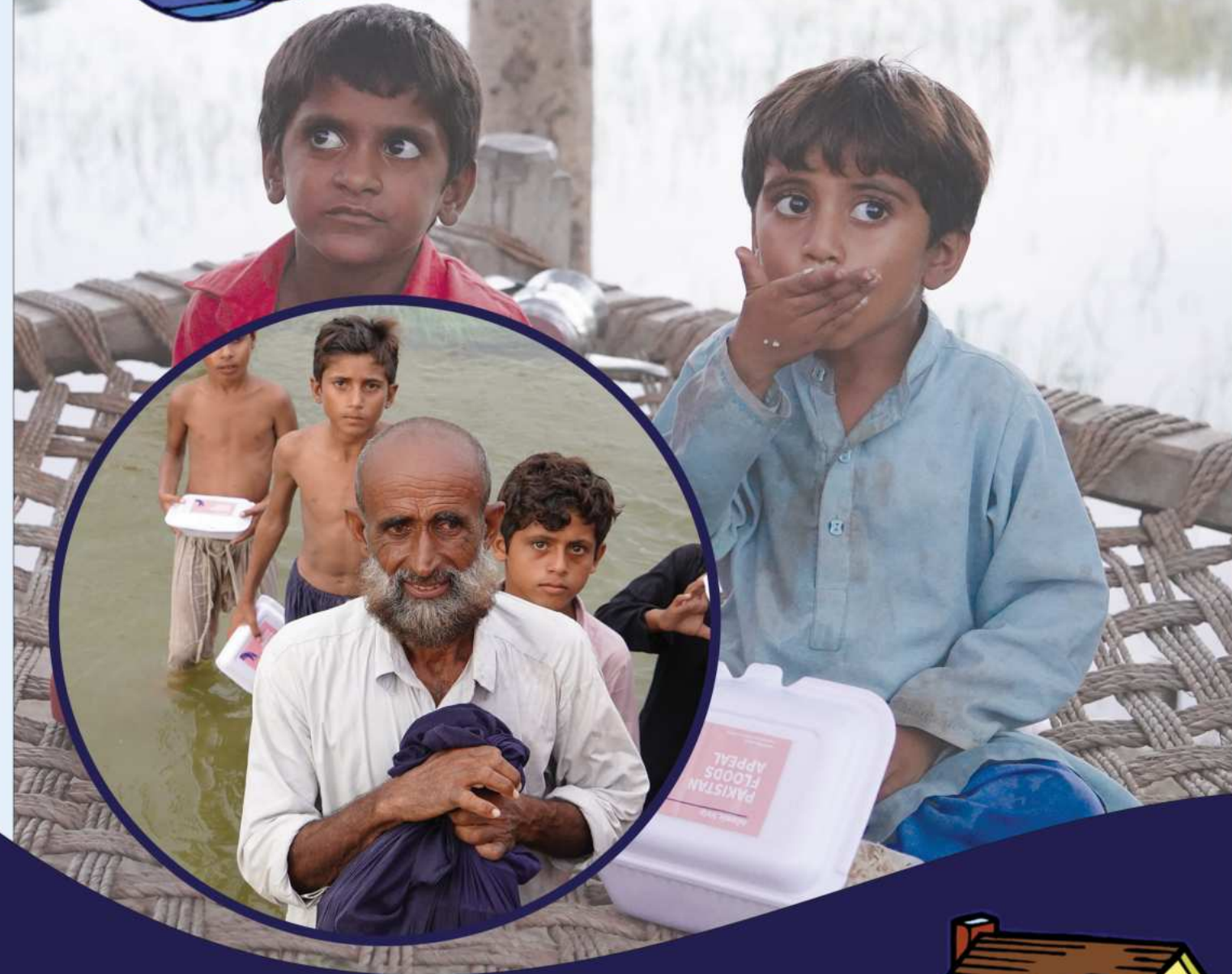
Through the distribution of 30 auto-rickshaws, we have created a steady source of income for individuals in urban and rural areas, improving their livelihood and reducing unemployment. These rickshaws serve as an essential mode of transportation, catering to the growing demand for affordable travel. In addition to providing income, this initiative has also enhanced mobility for passengers, making commuting easier and more accessible for many families.





Fruits & Vegetable Carts

By distributing 55 fruit and vegetable carts, we have empowered local vendors, particularly women and youth, to start their own businesses and become self-sufficient. These carts are equipped with essential supplies to ensure vendors can sell fresh produce in high-demand areas, improving their income potential and providing affordable, nutritious options to communities. This initiative has also contributed to better nutrition and food security, while fostering entrepreneurial spirit within the community.



DISASTER MANAGEMENT

Flood Relief Distribution



To prevent the spread of diseases, 612 hygiene kits were distributed, benefiting 4,290 indirect beneficiaries in disaster-struck areas.



Hygiene Kits

In response to devastating floods, we provided 15,200 individuals with cooked meals and 2,061 food packs to sustain affected families until stability was restored.



A total of 53 mud houses were constructed, benefiting 371 direct beneficiaries, with ongoing efforts to build an additional 147 homes. These houses were built with locally sourced materials, ensuring sustainability and reducing construction costs. The initiative focuses on providing safe, stable living conditions for vulnerable families in rural and underserved areas, helping them escape from inadequate housing and improving their overall quality of life.
